A copy of a valid letter from the U.S. Forest Service indicating that the use is consistent with the overall recreational plan, signed by the Forest Supervisor, shall be required prior to approval. 2. All buildings and structures on the property used in conjunction with the permitted use shall be located at least 50 feet from any street or highway or any habitable structure. 3. Use shall be located at least 300 feet from any public park or any area in a Residential Zone. 4. Minimum lot size is one acre. 5. Use shall meet all applicable health and safety standards and be reclaimed for open space use when declared safe for such use by the California Department of Health. 6. Minimum lot size is 10 acres. 7. Limited to hives only. 8. Minimum lot size is five acres. 9. Use shall be located within 600 feet of, or be in conjunction with, and intended to serve any use listed as permitted for the zone under the Recreational Uses category in Table 22.16.030-B, above. 10. Use shall be limited to a seating capacity not to exceed 500 seats. 11. Minimum lot size is one acre where sheltered employment or industrial-type training is conducted. 12. Use is permitted if publicly owned. 13. Minimum lot size is 100 acres. 14. Use is allowed in an open space easement if use is consistent with the intent and language of the applicable open space easement. 15. Use excludes airports and landing strips. 16. Use may also be subject to Chapter 22.120 (Density Bonus), Chapter 22.121 (Inclusionary Housing), or Chapter 22.166 (Housing Permits).
